# Scope of the role:

- Develop strategic medium- and long-term plans for all local IT infrastructure projects and applications, including the evaluation of new applications and software
- Prepare budgets and track costs for both, the daily business as well as for new investments and initiatives
- Manage IT local projects, including the training of local employees
- Ensure the reliable running of all IT services for Arbon Site without outages with regards to Infrastructure, Network, Security, Devices, Applications, Engineering Licenses and related areas of responsibility
